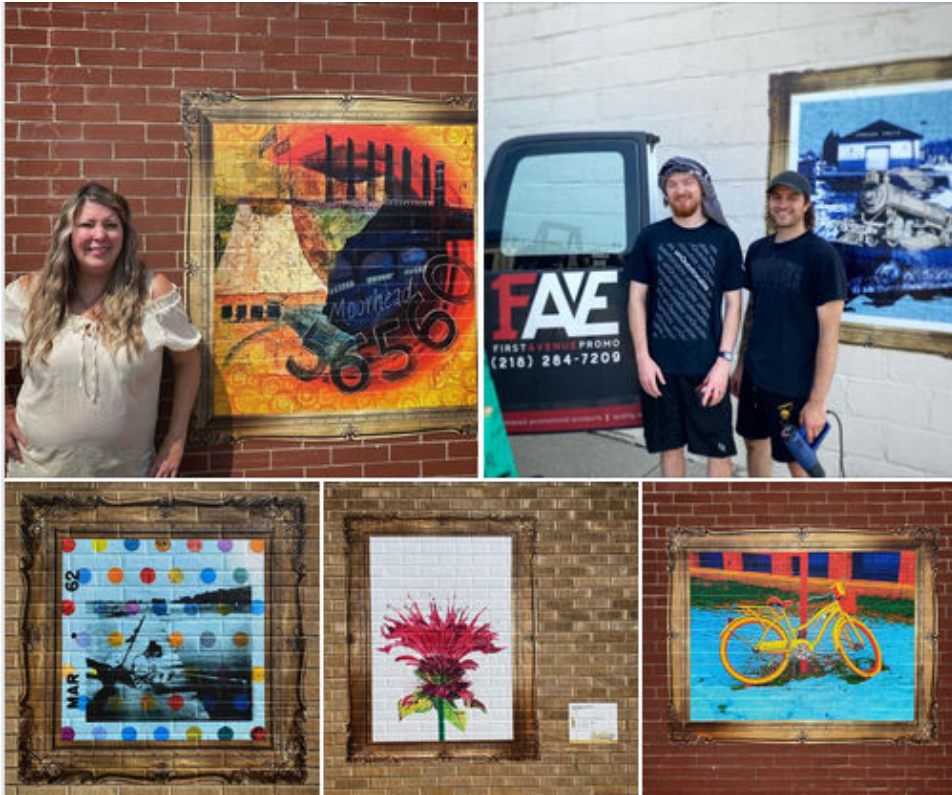

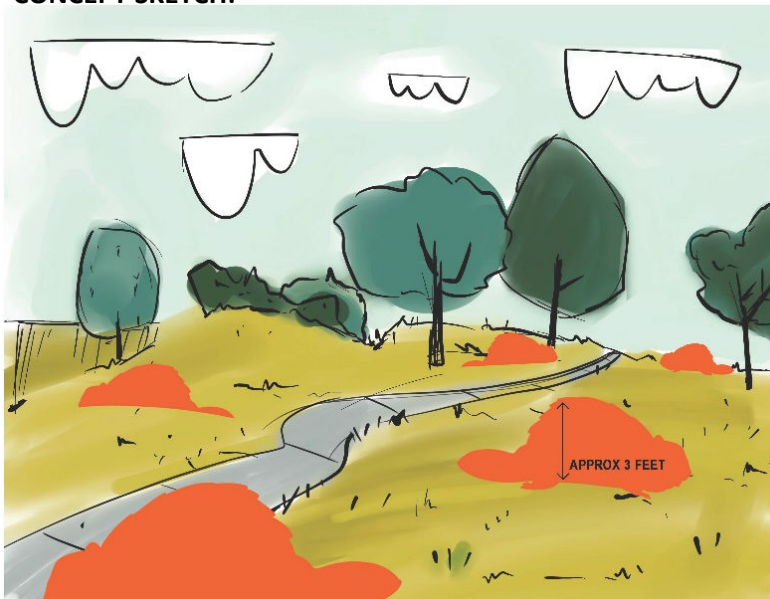
ONWARD MOORHEAD! COMPREHENSIVE PLAN
