**5. Reports and Information**

**a. The Photoville FENCE project – Guest Speaker: Danica McDonald, Special Projects Manager at The Arts Partnership**

Danica McDonald described the Photoville FENCE project. It is a national juried artwork featuring 85 photographers' works that is printed on vinyl over 1000 feet long. The project organized by The Arts Partnership will be located in three cities simultaneously - Moorhead, Fargo and West Fargo. The art that includes seven local artists from Minnesota, North Dakota and South Dakota. The project is sponsored by 702 Communications and FM Convention and Visitors Bureau (CVB). The locations and installation will be announced on The Arts Partnership Facebook page on October 5, 2020.

**b. I-94 Identity Tower Art Update – Guest Speaker: Michelle Churchill, project artist**

Michelle Churchill and Lisa Bode, Government Affairs Director provided history and a project update on the community engagement and artwork development process.. The final design is due to Moorhead Public Service by November 1, 2020 for installation the summer of 2021.
